LEAVING JESUS OUT OF THE REACH OF MILLIONS ... is just out of the question.

EVERYONE. EVERYWHERE. WHATEVER IT TAKES!

Underground. Secret. Classified. Whatever the term, there are times when silence is a good thing. In places where the gospel faces hostility for political or religious reasons, operating under the radar is the wisest course of action.

Remaining unknown and unnoticed is just one of the ways God has given Mission 865 momentum and a positive trajectory. This year we will likely reach the halfway mark of translating the *JESUS* film for 865 language communities with more than 50,000 speakers!

An undercover team using a robust community-based strategy and newly developed software operates in places we rarely speak openly about. We refer to this international team of faithful servants as Snap Dragon. No, this is not their real name.

In the past three years, Snap Dragon has led the way in some of the most challenging places, giving more than 36 million people a chance to hear Jesus speak their language! For security, many of these language communities in classified countries are listed on the Mission 865 website only by pseudonyms.

During the second half of this year, Snap Dragon will begin work in 56 additional language communities. Please pray for this secret, but highly impactful initiative. And pray for the people in unnamed places as they will one day soon have the JESUS film.

I'm thankful for your prayers and faithful support. And that's no secret!

Everlasting Love for Women

The man on the small screen captivated Yasmine. This elderly woman, watching *Magdalena: Released From Shame* in her North African home, had never before thought about following Christ. But as Jesus spoke with and cared for the women in the film, she realized how deeply He loved them—and loved women like her.

Yasmine quickly called her daughter and friends in to see the film, which was being streamed in Tasahlit (a dialect of Kabyle) on a satellite TV station. They were overwhelmed and amazed at how Jesus reached out to Magdalena and the other women in the movie. His care for these women and their needs touched the viewers' hearts.

"It is the best story I've heard," Yasmine later said. She explained that she placed her faith in Jesus because, when she watched Magdalena, she saw how He forgave the sins of the women who came to Him. After the film aired on TV, Yasmine went to her town's church, where believers had previously screened Magdalena. The people she met there gave her a DVD of the film, which she now cherishes.

"I did not believe Jesus would be interested in me also. At last I've found peace. Now I tell all my family and friends about Jesus." While Yasmine has joined the church, she can't always make it there in her old age. But she joyfully shares the love of her Savior with many women by showing *Magdalena* in her home.

Reaching Great Multitudes

Like the elderly woman, millions of North African Tasahlit speakers had the opportunity to watch *Magdalena* on television in December 2016. Although not

Christian, the channel also broadcast JESUS, giving Tasahlit speakers both films in their heart language. Global Church Movements (GCM) staff members in the region rejoiced as God answered their prayers to reach the multitudes with the life-changing story of Jesus despite persecution and the government's ban on evangelism.

Demand has soared! Thousands of nonbelievers keep requesting and receiving DVDs of these films. Local churches continue to host screenings with hundreds watching. Local ministry leaders plan to start Bible discussion groups as they follow up with the thousands enthralled by Christ.

Operation Snap Dragon has brought unique creativity and ingenuity to the process of making a JESUS film version in unwritten languages. Jesus Calms the Storm

A SMILE SPREAD ACROSS FEDIR'S FACE at the video clip about the disciples calling out to Jesus to calm the storm. After Fedir viewed the clip on the Jesus Film® app, he knew he wanted to use it to share his faith with others. A believer for two years, he had not yet learned how to evangelize. This was the reason he had come to today's event, a training session led by a Jesus Film Mission Trips® team.

Fedir teamed up with another national and a couple of Jesus Film staff members to evangelize in town. Right away they saw a man, Oleg, sitting on a park bench. After talking with him, they showed him the *JESUS* film segment "Jesus Calms the Storm" on a tablet, given to the local ministry by Jesus Film.

Fedir asked Oleg if he'd ever experienced storms in his life. Oleg said yes, stiffening in his seat as painful memories washed over him.

"Jesus calmed the storms in my life," Fedir said. He explained how Christ had saved him from a life of drunkenness and shame.

Fedir then asked Oleg if he would like to know how to have a personal relationship with Jesus. Oleg enthusiastically said, "Yes!" So, Fedir and his teammates used the tablet to go through a digital presentation of the Four Spiritual Laws using Cru's GodTools app. At the end, Fedir asked Oleg if he wanted to receive Christ's forgiveness. Once again the answer was yes.

Fedir later told teammates this was the first time he'd ever shared his faith with someone else. It also was the first time he'd ever seen someone trust in Jesus as Savior and Lord.

Fedir plans to follow up with Oleg and connect him with a local church. And he's more excited than ever about reaching others with the gospel using the media-rich Jesus Film app.

FINANCIAL UPDATE

WITH MORE THAN 1,600 MINISTRY PARTNERS who have financially participated in Mission 865 to date, this ministry is truly blessed. New languages continue to be funded as new ministry partners have committed to a language, thereby joining the team. Of the 865 languages on the list, 576 of the languages have been funded or committed to. More recording specialists have joined the team, so accelerated production of languages is anticipated. For the first time in a long time, there is a backlog of languages waiting to be recorded. Snap Dragon, our language production partner, will finish the India languages and has already begun working on Indonesian languages. The ministry remains on target for completing at least 67 languages this calendar year. To date, \$19 million has been given to Mission 865 toward finishing the 865 languages goal.
