Premiering the Zigula JESUS in Tanzania

IN JUNE 2015, a group of JESUS Film® staff, Global Church Movement (GCM) staff, and members of the Jacksonville, Florida, donor church traveled to Tanzania to premiere the Zigula version of the JESUS film. So efficient and effective was this particular trip that it is being considered a model of what future trips will look like.

GCM went ahead of the others and spent about three weeks training local pastors to do follow-up and church planting. They identified seven villages where they wanted to plant churches. Because the entire group was so large—about 35 members in all—they were able to do six or seven film showings each evening.

Every night the group would go out to 35 main villages and do film showings, and then the next day they would go back and do follow-up using the Swahili version of the JESUS film follow-up series, Walking With Jesus.

The group also organized an executive banquet, during which one of the businessmen church members of the team spoke. They handed out Zigula JESUS DVDs and followed up individually with each person who came. Seven of the area's top local leaders prayed to receive Christ. One of them was the manager of the hotel where the group was staying. She got so excited after seeing JESUS and the first two episodes of Walking With Jesus that she started sharing her faith with everyone. And although she came from a Muslim background, she organized a film showing in her village, which was just outside the town where the hotel was located. At that film showing, the hotel manager shared her testimony, communicating her heart in simple but sincere words; and, by doing so, she prompted the hotel owner's wife to receive Christ.

In addition to the film showings, the group did a lot of effective "tablet evangelism" and "tablet training," testing some new portable equipment for East Africa. Every afternoon the members would go out and use tablets with JESUS film segments and the God Tools app (just recently translated into English/Swahili) and talk to the townspeople who, for the most part, were very receptive. It was particularly exciting to see how involved the church members were in the premiere process. One of the group members who did a lot of the speaking at the premiere events was a church elder.

JESUS SPEAKS SUGU Recording Completed May 4, 2015

THE SUGU LANGUAGE, spoken by 150,000 farmers and hunters along the border of Maharashtra and Telangana, is very different from the state language, Marathi, and from Hindi. Viewing JESUS in either of those languages is very confusing.

The script was translated by a Bible translation team that has been working for a number of years on translating the New Testament.


In April, the Operation Snap Dragon (OSD) team of Indian nationals traveled to isolated villages to recruit voice actors, a dialogue director and some interpreters. They transformed a hotel room and bathroom into a soundproof recording studio.

Because the dramatic recording proceeded so smoothly with an outstanding director and actors, the team finished in near record time: seven days. Some of them got colds during the recording but, by God's grace, their voices endured.

When the Sugu JESUS recording was completed, the team presented it for the first time to a group of !

Sugu speakers, which included nonbelievers who had never been exposed to the gospel. Their reaction to the film was: "When can I get a copy?" "How much does it cost?" "Can I get more than one copy?" "I want to share this with everyone in my village. Now they can see why I am excited to follow Jesus!"

Seven organizations, including 47 leaders, pastors and evangelists who work in the Sugu language, braved challenging weather conditions on April 15 to meet and determine how to use this translation effectively. They plan to show the film once or twice a week in different villages, as well as in schools and universities, using mobile phones, TV screens, computers and projectors. They also plan to distribute the film via SD cards (for smart devices) and IESUS DVDs.

"DEAR BILL [WOLFE, DIRECTOR OF JESUS FILM GLOBAL PARTNERSHIPS],

Hope you are doing well in the Lord. We too are doing well....

I just wanted to update you on how we are doing since we parted in Bariadi. On the 10th of June to 17th, Anne and I had an opportunity of being part of a short-term mission project in Handeni in Tanzania.

We launched officially a new JESUS film for the Zigula people. This area has 93% Islam and 7% Christian. This is the summary of this mission:

- Total number of villages we showed JF 25
- Number of JESUS film showings 33
- Number of people reached through JESUS film 8,749
- Total number of new churches planted 5
- Number of people [who] prayed to receive Christ 714 adults and 466 children; total 1,180
- Number of people followed up using Walking With Jesus 297 adults and 407 children; total 704
- Dinner outreach The district commissioner was a special guest. Fifty
 district leaders, including some business persons, attended this event;
 seven prayed to receive Christ, and all of them were followed up the next
 day. Two others were followed up, including one top district leader.
- There were leadership seminars, couples, youth and single parents.

Last week we had a three-day 100-pastors vision conference in Dar Es Salaam, where they committed to planting 7,669 churches by 2020 in the coastal zone of LIFE Ministry church-planting."


Financial Update
